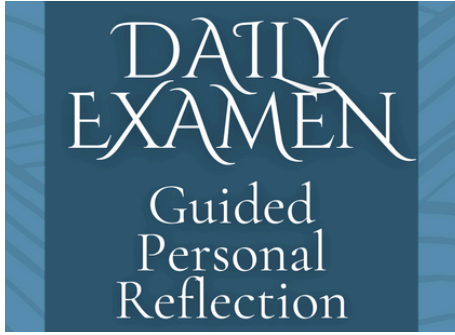


FIRST SUNDAY OF THE MONTH - AUGUST 4

We are excited to announcement that we will be renting our classroom space to **Prime Horizon**, a local adult day services company, on a trial basis, starting this week. We will learn if a longer term lease is a good fit for our church and for their operation. Additionally, this gives us time to fully understand insurance and tax implications of renting to a "for profit" entity. Currently, part of the space is being utilized by The Food Pantry on a temporary basis for their mobile food pantry (see *page 9*). We are pleased to be working with both organizations. We have received final bills from MEI for the shaft repair and a "not to exceed" bid from Otis to fix the electrical problems that prevents the fixed elevator from functioning.
