Although this is incredibly disappointing, it brings more clarity to the direction needed to repair the elevator with the result being a modernized elevator that is functioning and serviceable. We have an open insurance claim and will seek competitive bids as part of the process. Profound thanks to the Property Team for their work and diligence.
