## ELEVATOR UPDATE

Otis Elevator was here on Tuesday, March 25, and there is good news and bad news. The circuit boards that were sent out for repair were returned to church and reinstalled. When they were turned back on, nothing happened. It seemed that things were getting worse, not better. The elevator techs started looking at some basic things. When measuring power supply voltages, they got to a 48Vdc supply and their voltage reading was jumping around a lot. I suggested they switch the meter to measure Vac which should have measured almost 0, but as I suspected, measured a high value, 36Vac. Presumably, a filter capacitor most likely failed with age. This could easily explain why multiple things kept failing as the capacitor got worse over time. The result is that this is probably repairable, and, if nothing else was damaged, the elevator may work after this. The tech is waiting on the repair shop for further guidance.
