LOOKING AHEAD TO HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday - April 13, 9:00 a.m.

Our service begins with Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem as we pass out palms for everyone that we might celebrate like the crowds calling out, "Hosanna!" In continuing our tradition, the Fellowship Team will serve cinnamon rolls after the service.

Maundy Thursday - April 17, 7:00 p.m.

A day that commemorates Jesus's Last Supper with his disciples and reminds us the importance of humility, selflessness, and service to others. The word "Maundy" comes from Jesus' "command" to love one another given at the last supper and the word "Tenebrae" means "shadows". The service is characterized by the gradual extinguishing of candles, symbolizing the increasing darkness and sorrow of Christ's Passion.

Good Friday - April 18, 7:00 p.m.

In this powerful service, we contemplate Jesus' sacrifice for his disciples and the whole world. We depart in darkness and silence.

Easter Sunday - April 20, 9:00 and 10:30 a.m.

The identical services at 9:00 and 10:30 feature the joyful music of our Chancel Choir and the excitement of brass accompaniment to our hymns.
