

REQUESTS FROM THE FOOD PANTRY - MORE THAN JUST FOOD!

The Food Pantry is looking for volunteers. Do you know anyone with interest and availability?

-Delivery Person: Tuesday mornings at 9:00. Routes usually take about one hour and volunteers go in pairs. Must be able to lift grocery bags easily.

-Pick Up Person: Friday mornings at 10:30. Head to Costco to pick up bakery and produce. Volunteers drive The Food Pantry van along with 1-2 other volunteers, pick up the grocery items, and drive back to the pantry to unload and organize the goods. It rarely takes more than two hours. This is a rotating, flexible schedule.

-Spanish-Speaking Volunteers: Help translate for migrant families who come to the pantry during open hours (9:30-Noon and 4:00-6:00 on Tuesdays, and Saturday mornings 9:00-11:00) in June and July. Volunteers would not be required to be at each shift each week. Any assistance is appreciated.
