We are excited to announce that yoga will be returning to our church! Prior to the shutdowns caused by Covid-19 in March of 2020, many of you will remember an active yoga class here at church. Beginning this month, a new class is going to get started! Thanks to Susan Niederfrank for reaching out to Dawn Stacey, a yoga instructor and friend of the church, we will be hosting classes on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 beginning January 10. Here is a note from Dawn:

Hello, my name is Dawn Stacey. I am a PTA and a licensed yoga instructor with more than a decade of teaching experience. Over the years I have taught weekly classes at ZuZu Pedals, the Saukville YMCA, and the Port Washington Rec Center. I have taught chair yoga, mixed level classes, students, and athletes. My approach to teaching emphasizes a more personal approach to yoga, with a focus on helping students discover greater ease in their body through moment, breath, and meditation. I teach a slow alignment-based class with options to build poses throughout the class and a guided meditation at the end.

All levels of yogis are welcome and encouraged to come! I will have a few mats available for new students who are without personal mats and for anyone who might forget their mat. Class will be from 6:00-7:00 on Tuesday nights starting January 10. Please arrive 10 minutes early to allow for personal setup. Classes will be \$12 per class and be payable to me via check, cash, or Venmo. Hope to see you on the mat!
