


# Reopening Committee's Fall Survey Results – September 2021


Since we opened the church for in-person worship in May of 2021, please tell us if you have attended.

73 responses




The 2021/2022 program year begins on September 12, 2021. Do you plan to attend church in the coming weeks and at what time?

If your answer to the question above is "Will not attend" please tell us the reason.



If you are planning to attend in-person worship, how do you feel about requiring masks?


73 responses

What would you do if masks were optional?






- Not attend if masks are required.

When it comes to singing either by the congregation or by one of the choirs.


73 responses

Building maintenance updates – (Bill)- A total of three professional service invoices and proposals have been received for the Heat/Air Units; an invoice for air conditioner and two proposals to repair the unit and one for the fall/spring maintenance for a total of \$2700. This is under the budgeted amount. Bill has informed the council that the water tanks and the heating/air units are about 20 years old and will need replacing soon. Kathy is checking with Lorraine to see if there is a reserve of money that has been set aside from over the years for such repairs. Unfortunately, the stained glass windows are also in need of repair.
